HEARTWORM IS THE NUMBER 1 KILLER OF DOGS ON PROVIDENCIALES

HEARTWORM PREVENTION IS SIMPLE!

Take your puppy to the vet when it is 12 - 14 weeks old to have a simple blood test to determine if your dog has heartworm and make sure you buy heartworm preventative medication available in tablet form that **MUST BE** given to your dog **EVERY MONTH WITHOUT FAIL! IF YOU FORGET TO GIVE YOUR DOG IT'S MONTHLY HEARTWORM PILL IT COULD BE BITTEN BY AN INFECTED MOSQUITO AND CONTRACT THE DISEASE.**

YOU CAN ONLY BUY HEARTWORM PILLS FROM A VET
YOU CANNOT BUY THESE PILLS FROM IGA

PUPPY SHOTS - Puppy shots are necessary if you want to protect your puppy against a number of deadly diseases including:

DISTEMPER, PARVOVIRUS AND RABIES

TAKE YOUR PUPPY TO THE VET WHEN IT IS 8 WEEKS OLD TO HAVE IT'S FIRST SHOT AGAINST THESE DISEASES. YOUR PUPPY WILL NEED TO HAVE A FURTHER SHOT FOR THE NEXT 2 MONTHS AND A FINAL SHOT FOR RABIES. THEN EVERY YEAR YOU SHOULD TAKE YOUR DOG TO THE VET FOR ANNUAL CHECK UPS AND BOOSTER SHOTS TO MAINTAIN PROTECTION AGAINST DISEASES.
